Mediums: Students may use Oil, Pastel, Charcoal, or any other dry drawing media.

This Workshop will present to the participant the ways and means to achieving a solid portrait head study. Participants will learn to recognize the critical proportion relationships that initiate a likeness. They will also advance their awareness of and skills in, expressing form. Participants will be coached in their chosen medium and it's use in making tangible the observations made from life. All participants will be addressed based on their individual and specific needs.

Portraits done by Old and Modern Masters will be referenced as benchmarks to measure progress and clarify the technical and artistic issues related to the execution of a portrait. The instructor will perform "working demonstrations*" appropriate to the student group's needs.

* - Working Demonstration: Instructor does a demonstration while students work on their own paintings/drawings. This enables the student to monitor the demonstration while working through the very same procedure. It also allows the student to watch as much or as little as they feel is necessary.

Participants will make substantial inroads towards improving their visual and technical skill as it relates to the portrait head study. The student's individual style will be respected and considered in the coaching process.

Upon registration, students should declare their choice of media from which they will receive a modest supply list.
