Students will learn the fundamentals of composition working from photo references. Objectives will be to learn basic principles of composition including, unity, rhythm, value, focal point, balance, color, space and perspective. Starting with pencil thumbnails, the goal of the workshop will be to bring these to the level of a color study for a finished work. This is where the students use their imagination to create compositions while learning to express their ideas more effectively through the principles of composition.

Day one will begin with a presentation illustrating the objectives from master works, followed by the students working on their projects with individual critiques by the instructor.
